



**Fig 2.** Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature








**Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration**






**Fig 5.** Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values


 $T_j = 25^\circ C; I_D = 25A$ 


**Fig 6.** Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values


 $T_j = 25^\circ C; V_{DS} = 5V$ 


**Fig 7.** Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage


 $T_j = 25^\circ C; V_{DS} = 25V$ 


**Fig 8.** Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values




**Fig 9.** Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values




**Fig 10.** Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature



**Fig 11.** Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values




**Fig 12.** Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature








Fig 16. Package outline SOT404 (D2PAK)
